

Fabric Requirements

Small-scale, non-directional, tone-on-tone prints or solids work best for this quilt.

Background	4 ¾ yards	\bigcirc
Chicken Bodies	7 FQ in various colors*	
Quilt Blocks	7 F8 in various colors**	
Chick Body	1 Yellow F8	
Combs and Wattles	1 Red F8	
Beaks, Legs, & Wings	1 Orange FQ	
Leaves and Stems	1 Green FQ	
Flower Heads	Scraps or at least: Yellow: 6" square Pink: 7" x 11" Red: 7" x 11" Light Orange: 5" x 9" Orange***: 8 ½" square Light Purple: 6" x 11" Fuchsia: 7" x 11" Brown: 4" x 8" Sunflower Yellow: 9" square	(Flower 1) (Flower 2) (Flower 3) (Flower 4)
Binding	¾ yard	
Backing	5 ¼ yards	
Batting	80" x 90" piece	

Other supplies: In addition to basic quilting supplies, quilting clips for organizing fabric pieces are vital.

Yardage assumes a 42" usable width of fabric (WOF). Backing includes 4" overage for longarm quilting.

* A FQ leaves little room for mistakes with Chickens 2 & 4. Cut carefully or consider purchasing extra yardage.

** Choose fabrics that coordinate and contrast with the Chicken Body FQ. If desired, scraps from these F8s can be used for some of the flowers.

*** Scraps from the Orange FQ used for the Beaks, etc can be used in place of this 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
